LOCAL ARRANGEMENTS

The Evanston Holiday Inn is the official conference hotel and most sessions will be held there. Free parking is available at the Inn.

A registration desk will be set up at the Holiday Inn on Thursday evening, from 7 - 9 p.m., and on Friday morning, from 8:30 - 9:30 a.m.

At this desk, along with the registration packets, information on local events, transportation and directions will be available.

Coffee and doughnuts will be served on Friday morning at the Holiday Inn registration area and on Saturday morning at the meeting site, the Northwestern University Regenstein Hall of Music.

GETTING THERE

I. Airlines

O'Hare Field is closer than Midway Airport. From O'Hare, regularly scheduled limousine service ("Evanston-Skokie") is available to the Evanston Holiday Inn leaving every hour on the half hour, 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. Departure points are well-marked. The trip takes one hour and costs \$3.50. From Midway Airport, take a limousine to the Loop (Palmer House). From there see directions below for CTA trains to Evanston (Palmer House is adjacent to both elevated and subway trains).

Note: For return trip to O'Hare on Saturday (or Sunday), the limousines leave Evanston Holiday Inn every two hours, 8:40 a.m. to 8:40 p.m.

II. Train

From Union Station (adjacent to Loop) take a taxi (75¢) to Chicago & North Western station. C & NW trains leave for Evanston every 60 minutes (more often during rush hour). Get off at Davis St. in Evanston. Take taxi (75¢) or walk (5 blocks) to hotel.

III. Bus

Greyhound (arriving in Loop). CTA elevated tracks in back of terminal. Follow directions below for CTA.

Greyhound (arriving in Skokie). Taxi to hotel (\$4.00) or CTA

train ("Skokie Swift") to Howard St. (55¢); at Howard St. take taxi (\$1.00) or Evanston bus no. 201 (25¢) to Lake St. Walk one block to hotel.

Trailways (arriving in Loop). CTA elevated tracks $\frac{1}{2}$ block from terminal; State St. subway $\frac{1}{2}$ block. Follow directions below for CTA.

IV. CTA (Chicago Transit Authority) trains from Loop (50¢)

Elevated. Best choice (and view) is the "Evanston Express" (rush hours only). Get off at Dempster St. in Evanston. Walk 2 blocks north (on Sherman Ave.) to hotel. During non-rush hours, take "Ravenswood" train to Fullerton, change to north-bound "Howard St." train (same platform--no transfer required). At Howard St. change to Evanston train (same platform--no transfer required), get off at Dempster St. as above.

Subway. (below State St.) Take any ("A" or "B") "Howard St." train to Howard St. Change at Howard St. as above.

V. Car

Interstate 94 to Dempster St. East on Dempster about 5 miles to Chicago Ave. (1st light after only underpass enroute). Left on Chicago Ave. 2 blocks to Lake St., left 1 block to Holiday Inn.

MUSICAL EVENTS

Fall is the busiest season for live music and drama in Chicago, and there is a wide variety from which to choose. Details on programming are limited as of this writing, but will be available at registration. The Chicago Symphony Orchestra performs Oct. 20 (8:30), 21 (2:00), and 22 (8:30) at Orchestra Hall, Henry Mazer, conductor, and Peter Frankl, pianist. (Orchestra Hall, 220 S. Michigan Ave., 60604) Lyric Opera performs Mozart's Idomeneo, Oct. 21 (8:00) and Britten's Peter Grimes, Oct. 22 (8:00). (Lyric Opera of Chicago, 20 N. Wacker, 60606) Goodman Theatre productions are scheduled Oct. 20 - 23 (200 S. Columbus, 60603). Info on other events, including Northwestern University performances and folk/jazz/pop attractions, will be available later.
